Artwork Selection Process

the gallery on the corner fully represents and supports inclusive artwork and crafts produced by artists who have a physical or mental health condition or those from a disadvantaged background. It provides a platform to exhibit and sell artwork in a high profile location in the heart of Edinburgh's gallery district.

The selection process for receiving artwork to be sold in the gallery, including temporary exhibitions, is as follows:

Stage 1

In the first instance, anyone wishing to exhibit their artwork for sale at the gallery on the corner should submit their interest to the Gallery Manager either by email, phone or in person. The Gallery Manager will provide the interested artist with the relevant submission form for the gallery, to be filled in and completed by the artist. Electronic images should be submitted at this stage. The Gallery Manager will assess the work against the agreed criteria for showing in the gallery. If the submission is to be taken further, the Gallery Manager (or representative) will contact the artist to arrange a meeting.

Stage 2

The Gallery Manager will make recommendations to the selection committee and will forward on any relevant information to them about the artwork or proposed exhibition. The selection committee will comprise of four members; the Gallery manager plus three individuals bringing knowledge from their own area of expertise, namely the arts, autism and business.

The role of the selection committee:

The selection committee will meet every 3 months to assess work for the gallery. In advance of each meeting, the Gallery Manager will arrange a place, date and time for the meeting and will ensure that the selection committee have received images of the artwork for assessment.

At the meeting the Gallery Manager will give a short presentation on why they think the artwork being presented to the selection committee should be exhibited for sale. Each member of the selection committee will assess the artwork from the perspective they bring; art, autism and business.

Stage 3

The Board of Trustees may also be called upon where the selection committee have been unable to reach a decision. The decision made is final. Appeals should be made in writing to the Trustees.
